VI. PAST PRESIDENT'S REPORT - Carla Okouchi

Update on Teacher Evaluation Task Force

- The Task Force met on February 29, 2012. Instructional Services Staff Members presented sample Smart Goals. Specialists were there to share ideas for goals in ESOL, Health & P.E., Math, Language Arts, Social Studies, and Visual Arts. The current final Teacher Evaluation document was reviewed and a sample of what the new document might look like was presented. Weighting of Standard 7 was discussed at length without a general consensus.
- On March 19, 2012 the Task Force reviewed the matrices for Standards 1-6. A subcommittee used the Marshall model (*an open source*) as they worked to fine tune the

language. The Task Force discussed the matrices in groups and shared comments for the subcommittee to consider as they work on another draft. Human Resources shared a sample of what the final new Teacher Evaluation form might look like which includes all 7 Standards with the Rating of Highly Effective, Effective, Developing or Needs Improvement, and Ineffective. Attached was a draft of the Rating Matrices for Standards 1-6 and a copy of SMART Goal Setting for Student Academic Progress Form (sample document can be found on VDOE website page 50 in Guidelines for Uniform Performance Standards and Evaluation Criteria for Teachers)

- The goal-setting process is ongoing and from the discussion can be changed throughout the year. The process is a conversation between the teacher and administrator. It is the teacher who decides what the goal should be and will develop the ways in measuring student growth and achievement.
- The Task Force schedule of meetings will be extended into April.
- **Jeanette** spoke about the matter of assessing student growth for the evaluation process. Questions include: how big of a group of students, what content is being assessed and what grade? Considering the number of students that music specialists teach, assessment goals have to be realistic. Jeanette thought that 3rd grade recorder would be a good place to start assessing because of recorder pedagogy being a single, focused skill.
- Marian Schultz mentioned that the membership should look at a document that was shared with the faculty at Colvin Run ES: Teacher Evaluation Task Force Update/Superintendent's Teacher Advisory Council, March 7, 2012.
